

Blue Ridge Horse Force 2010 Sanctioning Guidelines

1. Sanctioning Fee: **\$50.00** for one day show, \$75.00 for two day show
2. Only one show offering 12 or more BRHF classes will be sanctioned on a given day.
3. No more that three shows at any individual private boarding/training facility will be sanctioned per calendar year.
4. Previously sanctioned shows will have first rights to the corresponding weekend of a new year when possible. Dates are **only reserved until March 1st** without payment for 2010.
5. The description of classes in show flyer **must match exactly** the wording shown on the attached page. Please look at this list, don't simply use last years flyer!!!! Sanctioned classes must be either listed with BRHF or an asterisk (*) denoting the class as sanctioned.
6. The show manager shall **email an electronic copy** of the program to the BRHF sanctioning contact **at least 30 days prior** to the show date so it can be checked for appropriate BRHF class designation.
7. Your show **will not be sanctioned** if flyers are distributed before being approved by the BRHF.
8. Once the flyer has been approved and distributed **NO changes are allowed** involving BRHF classes.
9. Upon request show managers will be sent a current list of mailing labels approximately 5-6 weeks prior to the show date. Flyers should be mailed to all BRHF members on this list **at least 2 weeks prior** to show date.
10. Results including class description, back number, horse name, and rider name must be mailed (or emailed) to the BRHF point keeper **within two weeks** of the show date.
11. Members of the Horse Force have been issued back numbers starting with 500. They are required to use these numbers at sanctioned shows to ease the point keeping. **Numbers below 500 should be used for entrants that are not BRHF members.**
12. Entries do not have to be a member of the Horse Force in order to ride in a sanctioned class. Members must join the BRHF before the show where they want their points to start counting.
13. Sanctioned classes can be split as long as the same horse / rider combination can not ride in both classes.
14. Show managers are responsible for ensuring all classes are run in accordance with the 2010 BRHF Rule and Divisions description.
15. **Safe and adequate parking, footing, and jumps are required at all facilities.** A site visit by a BRHF board member may be required.
16. Shows not following these guidelines may not be sanctioned in the future.
17. **The BRHF Board of Directors reserves the right to refuse / revoke sanctioning for any show.**
