

SWVHJA Information (Saturday)-

- Entry fees \$15.00 for Hunter Classes, \$20.00 for Warm-Up and Medal Classes
- A \$5.00 fee per class will be charged for going in classes not entered prior to the beginning of the class.**
- Neither the Bedford County Hunt Club, Randolph College, SWVHJA, nor any of their personnel will be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to horse, rider or guest.
- All riders must sign Equine release/waivers for both Bedford County Hunt and Randolph College.
- A negative Coggins report within the last 12 months must be recorded in the show office with your entry. *The horse's name on the coggins must match the name that the horse is shown under.*
- An EMT will be present on the showgrounds.
- Concessions will be available.
- All riders must comply with SWVHJA regulations regarding protective headgear.
- Horses or ponies that do not compete over fences in a SWVHJA recognized division may NOT compete in the under saddle class of that division.
- Entry and waive forms must be signed before competing.

- A negative Coggins Report within 12 months must be recorded in the show office with your entry. *The horse's name on the coggins must match the name that the horse is shown under.*

- All riders must wear an ASTM approved, properly fitted helmet while mounted on the show grounds.
- Entry and waiver forms must be signed prior to competing. A signed check must be left with the entry to receive a number.
