RULES & REGULATIONS

Governed by the BRHF and American Horse Show Assn Rulebook. It is **not required** to be a member of BRHF to compete in any class, **All classes will be counted towards the Double Nickel High Point Awards and Double Nickel Year End High Point Championships regardless of membership status.** There is no membership required for Double Nickel Open Show year end points. If competitors want points to be accumulated towards **BRHF year end awards, competitors need to be a member of the Blue Ridge Horse Force prior to show.** Visit www.BRHF.com for membership details. Dogs must be kept on a leash and under control at all times, Owner assumes all responsibility for their animal's conduct, **NO EXCEPTIONS.** English: coats, hard hat, boots required. Western: long sleeve shirts, hat and boots required (except lead line), chaps optional. Helmets or Hard hats required for children 12 and under. Novice is never having won 3 blue ribbons in any show.

Office opens: 7:30am Show Starts: 9:30am. Ribbons 1st through 6th.

Please check in at office even if you have pre-registered, to pick up your number & sign liability release.

1. **Coggins:** All horses on the grounds must have a negative Coggins within 12 months. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
2. Goodwill and sportsmanship are essential for a fun and safe show for all. Management reserves the right to bar any animal, exhibitor, owner, or spectator for inappropriate conduct.
3. The decision of the show judge is final.
4. No alcohol permitted on Show Grounds property.
5. All exhibitors must sign equine liability release waivers. Youth must have parent or guardian signature.
6. Neither Green Hill Park Equestrian Center, County/City of Roanoke, Blue Ridge Horse Force, Double Nickel Training & Horse Shows, nor any of its members, families, organizers, property owners nor employees shall be held responsible for accident, damage, injury, illness, or loss to the animals, personal property, exhibitors, spectators, or any other persons on the show grounds.
7. A two minute gate call and seven minute tack change will be enforced. Announcer must be notified of a tack change at least one full class in advance. 7 Minutes max will be allowed.
8. Dogs must be kept on a leash and under control at all times. Owner assumes ALL responsibility and liability for their animal's conduct, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
