Rules

1. The Show will be run according to 4H Rules.
 - a. ALL riders must be 9 years or older to participate.
 - b. 4H Members should bring a copy of their current health form.
 - c. All riders 17 and under must wear a helmet (ASTM approved) in mounted classes. (Parent Guardian responsibility to ensure helmet meets standards.
2. The show is open to the public-you do not need to be a 4H member, but 4H guidelines still must be followed.
3. Negative coggins within twelve months must be provided.
4. Show management reserves the right to add, cancel, or combine classes.
5. Goodwill and sportsmanship are essential for a fun and safe show, management reserves the right to bar any animal, exhibitor, owner, or spectator for inappropriate behavior.
6. Appropriate attire is encouraged, but not required.
7. Neither Parents, leaders, or any affiliate of the Franklin County 4H Trailblazer Horse and Pony Club, Virginia Cooperative extension, nor any of its members, families, organizers, property owners, nor employees shall be held responsible for accident, damage, injury, illness, or loss to the animals, personal property, exhibitors, spectators, or any other persons on the show grounds.
8. A two minutes gate call and five minute tack change will be enforced
9. MUST be a member of BRHF prior to show before points will count towards year end awards.
10. Call the contact numbers at the bottom in case of bad weather.
11. Judges decision is final.

Directions to Ginther's Farm:

From Rocky Mount on US 220 turn left onto Route 619 Sontag Road (beside the 619 Minute Market) at the Traffic Light-go past the Parks and Rec. Dept. Ginther Farm is on the right directly across from Sontag School-3128 Sontag Road, Rocky Mount, VA 24151-watch for the Trailblazer sign to turn in.

From Henry County take US220 towards Rocky Mount turn right onto Route 619 Sontag Road beside the 619 Minute Market at the traffic light- go past the Parks and Rec. Dept. Ginther Farm is on the right directly across from Sontag School-3128 Sontag Road, Rocky Mount, VA 24151-watch for the Trailblazer sign to turn in.
