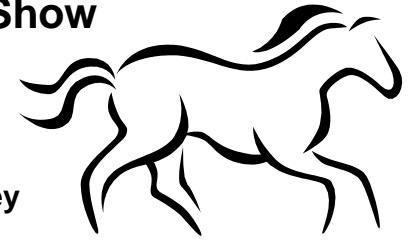

Rules & Regulations:

1. All entries must show a negative Coggins within twelve months.
2. Show management reserves the right to add, cancel or combine classes.
3. Goodwill and sportsmanship are essential for a fun and safe show for all. Management reserves the right to bar any animal, exhibitor, owner, or spectator for inappropriate conduct.
4. As this is a 4-H horse show, **youth under the age of nine years old will not be permitted to ride or handle a horse on their own.** They are, however permitted to show in classes while on a lead line.
5. Appropriate attire encouraged, but not required. **All youth 18 and under must have ASTM/SEI certified helmets. Safety headgear will not be penalized in any class.**
6. Concessions will be provided on the grounds.
7. No alcohol is permitted on Park grounds.
8. Neither Green Hill Park Equestrian Center, Blue Ridge Horse Force, Horseplay 4-H Club, nor any of their members, families, organizers, property owners nor employees shall be held responsible for accident, damage, injury, illness, or loss to animals, personal property, exhibitors, spectators, or any other persons on the show grounds.
9. A two-minute gate call and five-minute tack change will be enforced.
10. Directions to park: I-81 to exit 137, exit right 1/2 mile on Rt. 639 - Wildwood Road – to Rt. 11. At traffic light turn right on Rt. 11 south (also 460W and W. Main) and go 3/4 mile. At third traffic light turn left on to Rt. 639 - Diuguids Lane. Go 1 1/4 mile. The Equestrian Center is on the right at the second entrance to Green Hill Park.
11. Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
12. Stalls are available for \$20 each (with \$10 refunded upon presentation of clean stall.)
13. (*) Divisions refer to BRHF rules.
14. Entries and classes 41 and 42 may not cross enter into divisions with fences over 18” except the Hunter Hack classes.
15. Show management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes as entries warrant.

Awards:

1st – 6th place ribbons in each class.
