SHOW RULES

- ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn by anyone jumping. ASTM/SEI approved helmets are encouraged for all riders regardless of discipline and will not be penalized in any class (nor will the use of protective vests).
- 2. Cross entry between beginner hunter horse/pony and beginner hunter rider is not allowed.
- 3. BRHF or FCEC membership is not required to compete.

SHOW RULES

- 4. Dogs must be on a leash at ALL times.
- 5. The Botetourt County Horseman's Association, Franklin County Equestrian Club, Green Hill Park Equestrian Center, show management, any member, families, organizers, volunteers, property owners, or employees assume no responsibility in case of loss, injury, or damage to horses, persons, or personal property for any cause and admittance and entries are accepted **ONLY** on that basis.
- 6. VA Dept. of Agriculture requires that all equines on the show grounds must have a current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test.
- 7. Changes or additions or rules announced on show date take precedence over preprinted materials.
- 8. Show appropriate attire is encouraged but not required. Neatness is required. No string tops or shorts. Proper footwear is required. No tennis shoes, flip flops, or sandals.
- 9. Schooling will be allowed when the ring is not being used.
- 10. The Virginia Equine law is in effect.
- 11. Any entrant exhibiting unruly or dangerous behavior will be asked by management to leave the show grounds. Also, mistreatment of animals will not be tolerated.
