### **Show Rules**

- 1. ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn by anyone jumping. ASTM/SEI approved helmets are encouraged for all riders regardless of discipline and will not be penalized in any class (nor will the use of protective vests).
- 2. Cross entry between beginner hunter horse/pony and beginner hunter rider is not allowed.
- 3. BRHF membership is not required to compete.
- 4. Leave dogs at home.
- 5. The Botetourt County Horseman's Association, Mane Gait Equestrian Center, show management, any member, families, organizers, volunteers, property owners, or employees assume no responsibility in case of loss, injury, or damage to horses, persons, or personal property for any cause and admittance. ENTRIES are accepted **ONLY** on that basis.
- 6. Virginia Department of Agriculture requires that all equines on the show grounds must have a current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test.
- 7. Changes or additions or rules announced on show date take precedence over preprinted materials.
- 8. Show appropriate attire is encouraged but not required. Neatness is required. No string tops or shorts. Proper footwear is required. No tennis shoes, flip flops, or sandals.
- 9. Schooling will be allowed when the ring is not being used.
- 10. The Virginia Equine law is in effect.
- 11. Any entrant exhibiting unruly or dangerous behavior will be asked by management to leave the show grounds. Also, mistreatment of animals will not be tolerated.
